Please read the following email carefully as it contains important information regarding the dress rehearsal, arrival times, hair/makeup and costumes:

DRESS REHEARSAL

DO NOT GO TO MLACAK!

When: Friday, March 29, 2019

Where: Kanata Recreation Complex (100 Charlie Rogers Place)

Times: **Rain Scene and Painters**

Dress Rehearsal arrival time for skaters is 4:00 pm. We expect that skaters in this number will be finished by 5:30 pm.

Please note, there will be a "GRAND FINALE" practice at approximately 7:00. These practices will last roughly 20 minutes each. We ask that each skater attend as all Starskaters will take part in the Finale at the end of the show.

Fashion Models

Dress Rehearsal arrival time for skaters is 6:00 pm. We expect that skaters in this number will be finished by 7:30 pm.

Skaters should go directly to their dressing room. You may escort your skater to the dressing room, but unless you are a dressing room volunteer we ask that you just drop them off. We will have volunteers to supervise the skaters and to provide them with any assistance required.

Parents will not be permitted in the arena during the dress rehearsal as we only want you to see the finished product.

ICE SHOW (1 PM AND 6 PM PERFORMANCES)

When: Saturday, March 30, 2019

Where: Kanata Recreation Complex (100 Charlie Rogers Place).

Rain Scene and Painters and Fashion Models

Your skater will be performing in both the matinee performance at 1:00 pm and the evening show at 6:00 pm.

Skaters are required to report to their dressing room at 12:00 noon for the 1:00 pm show and 5:00 pm for the 6:00 pm show.

Time permitting, volunteers will try and bring small groups of skaters down to the arena level to watch portions of the show.

COSTUME / HAIR / MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS

HAIR REQUIREMENT

Juniors - Rain and Painters – Low ponytail

Juniors – Fashion Models – Bun in the middle

MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS

The club will supply the lipstick, but you must bring your own lip brush or cotton swabs. This will be less expensive than having everyone go out to buy their own lipstick. If you wish to buy your own lipstick at your expense, we are using – Maybelline #860, Pink Pop available at Shoppers Drug Mart. It is a very bright pink colour. If you can't find it, then please use another brand that is close to the same colour.

Foundation to match your skin tone.

Pinkish tone for blush.

Black or Charcoal grey eyeliner. Bottom and top of eyes should be outlined, with wings (have the corners come out and up).

False eyelashes are always preferred. If young skaters are not comfortable with false eyelashes, please use mascara

COSTUMES

Rain Scene and Painters

Skaters are required to wear black pants (no stripes or colour on the pants). The club will provide the rest of the costume.

Fashion Models

Skaters are required to wear beige tights (no over the boot tights). Skaters are required to wear shorts under their dress. The club will provide the rest of the costume.

IMPORTANT: Please note that all costumes are the property of MKSC. Please leave all costumes in the dressing room after the dress rehearsal and performances.
