Please read the following email carefully as it contains important information regarding the dress rehearsal, arrival times, hair/makeup and costumes:

DRESS REHEARSAL

When: Friday, March 29, 2019

Where: Kanata Recreation Complex (100 Charlie Rogers Place)

DO NOT GO TO MLACAK!

Dress Rehearsal arrival time for all Intermediate skaters is 4:00pm. We expect the dress rehearsal to be over by approximately 8:30pm so please factor in food for your skater!

Skaters should go directly to their dressing room. You may escort your skater to the dressing room, but unless you are a dressing room volunteer we ask that you just drop them off. We will have volunteers to supervise the skaters and to provide them with any assistance required.

Parents will not be permitted in the arena during the dress rehearsal as we only want you to see the finished product.

ICE SHOW (1 PM AND 6 PM PERFORMANCES)

When: Saturday, March 30, 2019

Where: Kanata Recreation Complex (100 Charlie Rogers Place).

Your skater will be performing in both the matinee performance at 1:00 pm and the evening show at 6:00 pm.

Skaters are required to report to their dressing room at 12:00 noon for the 1:00 pm show and 5:00 pm for the 6:00 pm show.

Time permitting, volunteers will try and bring small groups of skaters down to the arena level to watch portions of the show.

COSTUME / HAIR / MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS

HAIR REQUIREMENT

Intermediate – Table and Menus – High pony tail

Intermediate. - Waitress – Bun in the middle

MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS

The club will supply the lipstick, but you must bring your own lip brush or cotton swabs. This will be less expensive than having everyone go out to buy their own lipstick. If you wish to buy your own lipstick at your expense, we are using – Maybelline #860, Pink Pop available at Shoppers Drug Mart. It is a very bright pink colour. If you can't find it, then please use another brand that is close to the same colour.

Foundation to match your skin tone.

Pinkish tone for blush.

Black or Charcoal grey eyeliner. Bottom and top of eyes should be outlined, with wings (have the corners come out and up).

False eyelashes are always preferred. If young skaters are not comfortable with false eyelashes, please use mascara

COSTUMES

Tables and Menus Routine

Female skaters are required to wear black pants (no stripes or colour on the pants). Please keep your pants and shirts on as they will be used for the next number. The club will provide the rest of the costume.

Male skaters are to wear black pants (no stripes or colours on the pant). The club will provide the rest of the costume.

Waitress

Skaters are required to wear black pants (no stripes or colour on the pants). The club will provide the rest of the costume.

IMPORTANT: Please note that all costumes are the property of MKSC. Please leave all costumes in the dressing room after the dress rehearsal and performances.
