The CanSkate Program is resuming again this season and we are accepting applications from all new and returning qualified skaters who are interested in volunteering!

We are happy to be returning to higher registration numbers, and although restrictions will be lifted for on-ice physical distancing, we will still need to follow facility guidelines, which include continuing to maintain physical distance off-ice. We expect our PAs to comply with these requirements and help to manage flow of CanSkaters on and off of the ice.

The CanSkate Season will begin on September 12, 2021. **Please register to apply by September 3, 2021.**

2021/2022 Qualifications (Age as of September 1, 2021):

-Intermediate/Senior skaters 11 years and older

-Junior 2 skaters 12 years and older

All new PAs must complete 10 hours of on-ice training during CanSkate sessions before they can start earning credits. When you become a Program Assistant you are making a commitment to the MKSC CanSkate team. The CanSkate program could not run without you. You are expected to attend your sessions and if unavailable it is your responsibility to find a replacement.

Thank you very much for applying to be a Program Assistant for the 2021/2022 season. Applications will be reviewed based on age, skating level, experience, and availability. Successful candidates will be invited to the mandatory Program Assistant Training session and following the clinic, the 2021/2022 Program Assistants will be notified and given their schedules.
