STARSKATE 2021/2022 – REGISTRATION



The MARCH-KANATA Skating Club (MKSC) offers STARSkate sessions for STARSkaters of all levels. Skaters in these programs work on developing their skills in all disciplines of figure skating including skills, dance, freeskate and artistic.

Longer sessions may include a group stroking or conditioning component, which is led by our MKSC Professional Coaches. Skaters then work either independently or with their coach for the remainder of the session. Please refer to the “STARSkate Session Schedule” for the schedule for each session.

All STARSkate Sessions will be sized in compliance with Skate Ontario and City of Ottawa COVID-19 restrictions.

The season runs from September 7, 2021 until April 10, 2021. [Registration will open at 9am Saturday August 7, 2021](#), for MKSC Members. All skaters are welcome to become MKSC Members by purchasing a Skate Canada Membership and designating MKSC as their home skating club.

Skaters whose coaches submit an Admissions Request on their behalf and who are granted approval by Admissions to skate on specific sessions will be allowed to register for those sessions starting on **August 21, 2021**, if spaces are available.

Out of Club skaters may register on **August 25, 2021** as registration priority will be given to skaters registered as March-Kanata members with Skate Canada. Out of Club skaters should create an account Online, then email STARSkate.mksc@gmail.com to request registration for sessions and confirm level, payment will then be processed online.

Registration deadline is Sept 3, 2021. Registrations received after Sept 3, 2021 will be subject to a \$25 late registration fee per session. Registrations are also subject to a \$25 change fee per session for any changes to existing registrations.

OFF-ICE TRAINING

We are currently working on off-ice programming for Saturday mornings and hope to be able to share details as soon as we get confirmation on Mlacak hall availability for the season. We will share additional details soon.

MEMBERSHIP

To participate in any Skate Canada Program there is a mandatory annual Skate Canada membership fee of \$43.70 (**non-refundable**). This Skate Canada Fee is automatically added to your registration fees.

LATE REGISTRATION

Late registrations will be prorated along with a \$25.00 late fee per session.

REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY

No Refunds will be issued.

There will be a \$25 change fee to switch sessions after registration so please coordinate with your coach prior to registering.

For sessions cancelled by the City of Ottawa, where MKSC is refunded for the ice costs, skaters will receive credits on their accounts which can be used for future registrations. If a session must be cancelled for reasons beyond MKSC’s control, such as severe weather or arena closures, sessions will not be credited or rescheduled unless MKSC has been refunded for the ice costs.

In the event that the season is shut-down as a result of the pandemic, future installments will not be processed and credits will be issued for the difference between the amount that has been collected to date and the sessions that have already taken place.

Sessions missed by a skater cannot be made up another time.

Unfortunately, given our ice costs are fixed, we are unable to issue credits for sessions missed because of skaters being sick or needing to self-isolate because of COVID-19. Non-COVID related medical credits will be issued to skaters who miss more than 2 weeks of skating sessions and provide a medical certificate to the STARSkate Director.

ROWAN’S LAW Acknowledgement

All STARSkaters or Parents/Guardians of STARSkaters under 18 years old must read the Government of Ontario Concussion Awareness Resource for their age group and the Skate Ontario Concussion Code of Conduct [Skate Ontario - Rowan's Law](#). This needs to be completed each year. An acknowledgment will be required during registration.

COVID-19 Waiver

All individuals participating in March-Kanata Skating Club’s activities MUST complete the Skate Ontario Acknowledgment, Release, Indemnity and Assumption of Risk regarding COVID-19 (“[COVID-19 Waiver](#)”). Participants include: Skaters, Coaches, Board Members and Volunteers. For participants under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must complete a form for each participant. TEST DAYS

To participate in Test Days, members must be in good standing with MKSC. Scheduled Test Days at MKSC are November 21, 2021, February 11 & 12 2022, and April 8 & 9 2022.

SUPERVISION

Skaters are not permitted on the ice without a coach or an executive member with first aid training present with their eyes on the ice. As our coaches are focused on providing skating instructions, **parents/guardians of young skaters (under 12 years of age) are required to be in the arena to supervise their skaters.**

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

March-Kanata Skating Club is entirely run by volunteers. For the club to continue to operate without being forced to raise fees and hire administrative staff, we need all parents and skaters to contribute their time. [Volunteer Policy](#)

MUSIC PLAYING DUTY

Due to COVID-19 restrictions the [Music Playing Policy](#) for this season will be reviewed.

LOCKERS

A limited number of lockers are available for rent at a cost \$50 for the 2019/2020 skating season. Lockers can be purchased through the on-line registration system. [Locker Rental](#)

DANCE PARTNERING

Dance partnering lessons are not currently available. Skaters can test dances solo or be shadowed.

QUALIFICATIONS

How does it work?

- A skater is credited with points for every test passed in each of the disciplines (FreeSkate Program, FreeSkate Elements, Skills, Artistic and Dance). The number of test points allocated to each test is outlined in the **MKSC Points Allocation Matrix 2021/2022**.
- If a skater wishes to skate on a session for which they do not qualify, a request must be submitted in writing by the Skater's Coach to the STARSkate Director. The request will be evaluated by the Admissions Committee. Priority will be given to skaters qualified to skate on a session.
- If you are unsure of how many points your skater has, please contact the STARSkate Director. A skater is credited with points for every test passed before **June 30, 2021**.
- Ideally the MKSC Points system will remain constant, however we may adjust the session requirements each year depending on anticipated registration levels.

**Skaters MAY NOT request music during a session.

Registration Instructions

Prior to attempting to register your skater online please review the programming available (described below) based on your skater's level and determine which ice sessions you wish to register for.

Please review your selections with your coach before registering.

If you have not yet hired a MKSC coach, you should do this prior to proceeding. Here is a link to our Coaches Biographies [Coaches Biographies](#).

Your skater's coach will provide recommendations on how often they would like to see your skater on the ice and may provide recommendations for exercise off the ice. You should review your schedule with your coach prior to registering to ensure that they have availability to coach your skater on the sessions that you have selected.

Eligible Program Assistants are asked to register online to be Program Assistants for the 2021/2022 Season by Sept 3, 2021. [PA Registration](#)

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payment can be made via debit or credit card. Given we are still dealing with a global pandemic and we are an organization that is fully run by volunteers, we will only have 2 payment options this season:

- 1). Payment in 7 Installments (Highly Recommended):
 - At Registration - Skate Canada Registration Fee plus 1/7th of Session Fees
 - October 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
 - November 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
 - December 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
 - January 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
 - February 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
 - March 1st - 1/7th of Session Fees
- 2). Payment in full at the time of registration

Skaters with PA Credits that either cover their full registration fees or almost cover their full registration fees may select the option to pay in full at the time of registration which will result in their PA Credits being applied to their balance and any remaining balance will be due at this time.

If Skaters with PA Credits choose the installment option, they will need to pay their first installment but each of their subsequent installments will be reduced until their PA Credits are fully used up.

Please note that by registering for a session, you are contractually agreeing to pay for the full session unless the arenas are closed by the City of Ottawa as MKSC is contractually obligated to pay the City for the ice. The installment plan is simply a payment plan. You are required to make all 7 payments.

If the arenas are closed, and programming is cancelled we will not process any further installments. As per our refund policy below, we are recommending that all skaters chose the installment plan for this upcoming season given the uncertainty created by the pandemic.

When you select the installment option, you are pre-authorizing the next 6 payments on your credit card. Please ensure that you are either using a credit card with an expiry date after March 2022 or that you are making a note in your calendar to provide us with an updated credit card prior to its

expiry to avoid the \$25 Administration Fee if your credit card is either unable to be processed or is declined for any reason when your installments are due.

Finally, we have included below the terms and conditions that you will be asked to agree to in the online registration tool to finalize your registration.

Terms and Conditions (must be accepted to complete registration):

- The March-Kanata Skating Club (MKSC), its board members, volunteers and coaches are not responsible for any accidents, injuries, or loss of personal belongings either on or off the ice.
- I hereby authorize MKSC to place my child's name and/or photo on the arena bulletin boards, trophies, programs, newsletters, newspapers, or website.
- I understand that my child cannot go on the ice without being registered properly for the session being skated. Registration fees and/or installments payable to MKSC must be up to date.
- I understand that a \$25.00 administration fee will be charged if my credit/debit card is either unable to be processed or is declined for any reason when my installments are due and that it is my responsibility to ensure that I have provided the club with updated card information prior to each of my installments being due.
- I understand that sessions with insufficient registration will be either cancelled or repurposed.
- I have read and understand my obligations under the Music Policy and the Volunteer Policy
