



**MARCH-KANATA SKATING CLUB
PRE-JUNIOR 2022/2023 – REGISTRATION**



PROGRAM

Pre-Junior is the next step in our Learn-to-Skate programming.

This is the perfect class for your son or daughter to continue developing the fundamentals taught in our CanSkate program. Pre-Junior introduces more advanced exercises designed to improve edge control, glide, agility, and precision over the blade.

Pre-Junior on-ice classes are taught in a group format by our certified Professional Coaches. Our off-ice sessions develop coordination, motor skills, suppleness, speed and confidence.

Designed for children aged 4-13, who have completed CanSkate Badge 3 or been recommended by one of our coaches, Pre-Junior can accommodate those looking to gain an edge in their skating ability, as well as those wishing to pursue the sport of figure skating.

The season runs from September 14, 2022 until March 11, 2023. Registrations received after Sept 14 will be prorated.

ON-LINE REGISTRATION: MKSC requires all skaters to register on-line at www.mkskate.ca

MEMBERSHIP

The registration fee includes program fees and a mandatory Skate Canada membership fee (**non-refundable**).

REFUND

No Refunds will be provided

CANCELLATION

If a session must be cancelled for reasons beyond MKSC's control, such as arena closure, sessions will be refunded. Sessions missed by a skater cannot be made up at another time.

SUPERVISION

Skaters are not permitted on the ice without a coach or an adult with first aid training present with their eyes on the ice. As our coaches are focused on providing skating instructions, **parents/guardians of young skaters (under 12 years of age) are required to be in the arena to supervise their skaters.**

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

March-Kanata Skating Club is entirely run by volunteers. For the club to continue to operate without being forced to raise fees and hire administrative staff, we need parents and skaters to contribute their time.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

You can choose from 2 payment options:

- 1) Payment in full at time of registration with Debit or Credit Card
- 2) Payment of 20% at time of registration + Payment of 20% on October 1st, November 1st, December 1st, January 1st 2023 with Debit or Credit Card (preferred method)

The Pre-Junior Program is made up of two 50-minute coached ice sessions and one 45 minute instructed off-ice session per week. Registration is for the entire program only. The individual sessions are NOT available for sale individually but can only be purchased as a package.
